The CPDP and CPDP LatAm community wishes to salute Professor Danilo Doneda, expressing deep regret for his death, occurred on Sunday, 4 December 2022.


Danilo was a bright mind, a pioneer in the field of privacy and data protection, and most of all an exceptional human being. As an intellectual, he marked the trajectory of privacy and data protection in Brazil and Latin America. As a person, he marked the lives of the large number of individuals who had the pleasure of working alongside him, learning under his guidance, laughing, and enjoying life with him.

Danilo played a major role in the elaboration of the Brazilian General Data Protection Law (LGPD), contributed substantially to the process leading to the adoption of the Brazilian Digital Rights Framework, the Marco Civil da Internet, and shaped the evolutions of countless national and international policy efforts related to data governance.

He has left many colleagues, friends, students, and companions, all saddened and honoured for having shared his immense generosity of spirit. He has also left a rich legacy for the field of data protection and will remain a fundamental pillar of CPDP LatAm. His contribution to the foundation and establishment of CPDP LatAm was essential. To honour his memory, the CPDP LatAm community has created the "Danilo Doneda Award" recognising every year the best Latin American interdisciplinary papers, amongst the CPDP LatAm publications. The Brazilian Data Protection Authority (ANPD) has also established the "Premio Danilo Doneda" to acknowledge the best student dissertations dedicated to data protection, at the Brazilian level.

Danilo's spirit, works, and most of all his contagious cheerfulness, will continue to be alive and carried forward by all of us.
